**1. JURISDICTION**

This event is a National Rally, promoted by Rally New Zealand and will take place on Saturday 7 August 2010 in the Gisborne Area.

The Rally will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Three, Schedule R being the Standing Regulations for all Rallies and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

### **5. SERVICING AND REFUELLING**

Servicing can be carried out in a safe location anywhere on the route so long as the Public and residents are not inconvenienced and the traffic flow on the road is not restricted.

There are three opportunities provided in the itinerary to service, after SS2, SS3 and SS5. There is no specific time allocated. The time shown in the itinerary is an estimate only. Refuelling – competitors may refuel anywhere on the route.

All competitors are reminded of their responsibilities under the MotorSport New Zealand Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel.

### **6. WITHDRAWALS AND REJOINING**

As per Article 12C of the Supplementary Regulations Part 1 competitors may rejoin the rally at TC's 3,4 and 6. Competitors wishing to rejoin must advise the Competitor Relations Officer or Clerk of the Course before their scheduled report time to the TC.

If the vehicle has been damaged the competitor needs to gain clearance from the Chief Scrutineer before rejoining.

Rejoining competitors will be reseeded at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

## 10. LIVERY REQUIREMENTS

Competitors will be issued with the following livery to be affixed to their car.

- 250mm high black on white numbers to be affixed to the rear side windows.
- 500 x 150mm white on black stickers "GISBORNE" to be affixed to the top of the doors in Position B3 as shown in Schedule R.
- Geartech Central Region Rally Series stickers to be affixed on the doors or front guard in Position A1 as shown in Schedule R.
- Stilo Top Half Series stickers to be affixed on the doors in Position B2 as shown in Schedule R.

*Please note that all livery is compulsory and is not dependant upon being registered for either series.*
