

## Gisborne Rally Saturday 10 September 2011

### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS: PART ONE

#### 1. JURISDICTION

This event is a National Rally, promoted by Rally New Zealand and will take place on Saturday 10 September 2011 in the Gisborne Area.

The Rally will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Three, Schedule R being the Standing Regulations for all Rallies and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

### 3. THE EVENT

- 3.1** The event will be a one day rally and will take place on country gravel roads in the Gisborne district.
- 3.2 Length:** Comprises of 173.86 km of 6 special stages and 237.32 km of touring.
- 3.3 First Car Starts:** From Gisborne Cosmopolitan Club, 190 Derby Street, Gisborne at 0800 hrs on Saturday 10 September. Cars must report to the pre-start area 15 minutes before their start time.
- 3.4 First Car Finishes:** At 1645 hrs at the final control which is situated at the Gisborne Cosmopolitan Club, 190 Derby Street, Gisborne, on Saturday 10 September.

### 4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 Opening and Closing:** These open with the publication of these regulations and close at 1700hrs on Friday 26 August 2011.

Late entries may be accepted until 1200 hrs Thursday 8 September, with an additional \$150 fee.

- 4.2 Entry Acceptance:** Entries shall be made on the correct form and to be deemed valid must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the organising committee's discretion. Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

**4.3 Fees:**

- (1) Competing vehicle;

Entry Fee \$645 including GST and 2 x Dinner Tickets

The entry fee includes:

- One set of Road Books
- Two Route Maps
- Vehicle Livery Pack
- Two Dinner tickets

Late Entry Fee is an additional \$150.00 including GST.

- (2) Dinner Tickets

Dinner tickets are \$35 each- we suggest you pre purchase when you enter as numbers are limited.

- (3) Service Crew:

Registration is included in entry fee

- (4) Stage Notes

Please note that stage notes are to be ordered using the attached form directly through Neil Allport Motorsport Ltd.

Please use the driver's surname as a reference when making the payment and ensure the entry form is marked accordingly. All charges incurred by the bank must be charged to the sender.

When paying by Telegraphic Transfer or Direct Credit it is essential that you provide details of this payment by fax to the Rally Office to ensure that payment is received prior to the close of entries.

The Entry Fee must be received in full by the organisers within 2 days of the close of entries. If the Entry Form is sent by fax or email the original must reach the organisers within 7 days following the closing date of entries.

### Refunds

Entry Fees will be refunded in full only:

(a) To candidates whose entry has not been accepted.

(b) In the case of the rally not taking place.

No other refunds will be made.

#### 4.4 Number of Starters:

The organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if less than 40 entries are received at normal closing date. The maximum number of starters will be 120.

#### 4.5 Acceptance of Entry:

These will be notified by Friday 2 September together with the seeded start list and Supplementary Regulations Part 2.

#### 4.6 Competitor Requirements:

**(1) Knowledge and Understandings:** In signing the entry forms competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules.

Particularly,

(a) The National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and

(b) Appendix Three Schedule R articles pertaining to Stage notes, Pace notes and Reconnaissance.

**(2) Licence Requirements:** Both the No. 1 and No. 2 drivers shall hold a National Rally Grade or higher MotorSport NZ issued Competition Licence.

If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrants licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

**(3) New Competitors:** Any driver(s) who has not previously competed in three or more rallies must attend the new competitor briefing.

The New Competitor briefing will be held at 2000 hrs on Friday 9 September at VTNZ Gisborne, 384 Childers Road, Gisborne.

## 5. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

**5.1 Compliance:** All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A and Appendix Three Schedule R of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

#### 5.2 Classes:

Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

A	0 – 1400cc	2WD
B	1401cc - 1850cc	2WD
C	1851cc and over	2WD
D	Open	4WD
E	Pre 1996	4WD complying with Top Half Rally Series and Central Region Rally Series Articles

## 6. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT

#### 6.1 Documentation

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licences and documents, issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material prior to presenting the car for audit scrutineering and for those cars with forced induction engines, restrictor inspection. Cars will not be cleared to compete until all livery requirements are in place.

Documentation will take place on Friday 9 September from 1900 – 2030 hrs at VTNZ Gisborne, 384 Childers Road, Gisborne

## 11. STAGE NOTES

The use of Stage Notes is permitted provided that the competitor has purchased Stage Notes as created for this Event and supplied by the MotorSport NZ authorised provider, Neil Allport Motorsport. Competitors are allowed to use any stage notes embellished from stage notes used previously on the event or write fresh notes for any event

For those competitors wishing to purchase the Stage Notes where they are not included in the entry fee it is essential that they advise of their intention on the box provided on the entry form and submits the stage note request form with payment direct to Neil Allport Motorsports.

The cost of the notes for this event is \$230.00

*Information: The stage note system uses an automated computer program to generate a description of the special stage road using sensors fitted to a vehicle driven through each stage.*

*Such notes describe the route in more detail than the Road Book and can be used without reconnaissance. The purchase and use of the stage notes is a direct contract between the competitor and Neil Allport Motorsport with the organiser's involvement being limited to authorising the use and facilitating the preparation and distribution on behalf of Neil Allport Motorsport.*

*There is no obligation on any competitor to purchase these stage notes.*

## **12. GENERAL**

### **A Official Time**

Official time throughout the entire rally will be set from the Industrial Research Ltd Talking Clock: Telephone 0900 45678

### **B Servicing & Refuelling**

Rally cars may be serviced anywhere along the Rally route with the exception of any areas on State Highway 2 (Note – Refuelling only at Rakauoa Road/SH2 junction is permitted).

A specific service area after SS 2 Wharekopae and SS 4 Rakauoa along the left hand side of the road for 8.92 km between Road Book box 22 and box 23 has been created. Please take care to keep as close as practical to the left hand side of the road so as not to impede the flow of traffic.

Refuelling may be undertaken anywhere along the Rally route or in the designated service and refuelling areas as outlined in the Road Book.

All competitors are reminded of their responsibilities under the MotorSport New Zealand Code of Practice for Motorsport Fuel.

### **C WITHDRAWALS & REJOINING**

All withdrawals either temporarily or permanent must be reported to Rally Control as soon as possible.

Competitors, who have handed in a temporary withdrawal form or have phoned a temporary withdrawal to Rally Headquarters, have the opportunity to rejoin the rally after service. Competitors wishing to rejoin must advise the CRO Mark McLean located at Matawai Hard Drive Café & Service Station or via telephone Hard Drive Café on 06 862 4823 before their scheduled report time to the next TC after service.

If the vehicle has been damaged the competitor needs to gain approval to rejoin from the Chief Scrutineer.

Rejoining competitors will be reseeded at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course Stuart Barnett who can be contacted on 027 629 3516.

### **G Prize giving and After Event Function – Gisborne Cosmopolitan Club 1830 hrs**

Dinner will be served from 1830 hrs with the Prize giving commencing at approx 1900 hrs. The cash bar will open at 1700hrs. The buffet dinner will cost \$35 per head and tickets will be available for pre - purchase with entry with only limited numbers available at documentation. Tickets will not be available for purchase on the night. Two tickets are included with entry.

### **I Livery Requirements**

Rally Plates and Competition Numbers will be provided by the Organisers and must be affixed as advised in the Acceptance of Entry.

Competitors will be issued with the following livery to be affixed to their car.

- a. 250mm high black on white numbers to be affixed to the rear side windows.
- b. 500 x 150mm white on black stickers "GISBORNE" to be affixed to the top of the doors in Position B3 as shown in Schedule R.
- c. Geartech Central Region Rally Series stickers to be affixed on the doors or front guard in Position A1 as shown in Schedule R.

Please note that all livery is compulsory and is not dependent upon being registered for either series.
