### To all Competitors

#### Documentation on Saturday

Will be restricted to **ONE** vehicle per competitor.

#### Scrutineering on Saturday

Will be restricted to **ONE** vehicle and trailer per competitor.

#### Tickets, access and parking

You will receive 6 tickets (including driver and passengers) to the Battle of Jacks Ridge. **These will be emailed to your email address provided on your entry form.** These tickets will allow you access before normal gates open at 10:00am and are intended for teams and crew.

Any additional tickets to the six you will receive as part of your entry, will need to be purchased via ticket fairy as GA tickets. Access with GA tickets is not until 10:00am. **Please note GA tickets will be sold out in the next couple of days.**

You will receive two vehicle passes with your entry. One will give you access to the Service Park, the second crew vehicle will need to be parked in a designated off-site car park. There will only be space for one service vehicle and one for your competition car. If you are servicing from your trailer, then your trailer can remain on-site but both your service vehicles must park off-site. We will have a shuttle bus on between 6:30am and 9:30am for runs between the off-site park. Please note, the trailer park and the off-site park for service vehicles will be the same location. Please apply the Service 2 sticker to the vehicle that will be parked off-site with the trailer.

We cannot issue additional car passes. If you need more car passes, you will need to buy these online, however please note, these car passes will give access to the GA parking area which is a significant distance from the Service Park, from 10:00am.

The venue is limited with onsite parking options plus we're expecting the event to be a sell-out. We suggest you look closely at your crew numbers and try and bring only those necessary.

#### Sustainability:

- We will not be providing printed regulations or any bulletins prior to the event – these will be available on the event digital noticeboard on event and will be emailed to competitors. On event we will provide printed bulletins.
- We will have rubbish, recycling, and compostable bins in the service park. We will also have a drum available for all used oil containers (that will then be recycled) – please utilise this drum and do not throw used oil containers in the rubbish.
- The Environmental Officer will be on site, if you do have a spill, we can help you clean it up – please advise an official
- There will be a labelled container for used oil containers in the service park – these containers will be taken away and recycled appropriately, please do not throw them in the rubbish
