Saturday Afternoon - Jacks Ridge access, ticketing and parking

You will have access for 6 people (including driver and co-driver) to the Jacks Ridge stage. Wristbands will be issued. These wristbands will give access to the service park and also the Nation Bar and viewing platform which will have a cash bar facility during the stage and post event. There will be food available to purchase as well.

You must have a wristband to enter the venue (including drivers and co-drivers).

The viewing platform at Jacks Ridge is for teams, crew and sponsors only (not general public).

Any further tickets required for the Jacks Ridge stage will need to be purchased at the gate and will have a different viewing area to teams and sponsors (please note tickets on the gate will be very limited and are first in, first served).

Parking will be limited to **TWO VEHICLES ONLY** on Saturday afternoon at Jacks Ridge. Any additional cars teams have onsite will be sent to the spectator viewing area.

BBQ Fundraiser – Friday evening during documentation/scrutineering

There will be a BBQ/Sausage sizzle on Friday evening at Jacks Ridge. This will be a fundraiser for the local Scouts group. Please make sure you bring some cash to support this.

Sustainability

- We will not be providing printed regulations or any bulletins prior to the event – these will be available on the event digital noticeboard www.cityofaucklandrally.co.nz on event and will be emailed to competitors. On event we will provide printed bulletins.
- The Environmental Officer will be on site, if you do have a spill, we can help you clean it up – please advise an official.

Service Park – Kumeu Showgrounds

Teams will be allocated a designated service area of approximately 8m x 9m in the service park.

Reconnaissance reminder

Art 9.1 Reconnaissance sign in is behind the Gull Service Station at Kaukapakapa from 8:15 to 9:05am on Friday November 13th.

Remote Refuel Zone – Kanohi Road, Kaukapakapa

The Remote Refuel Zone will be on Kanohi Rd after SS 2 / 5 Puhoi.

Depart from the Kumeu Service Park and head north on HW16, or via Old North Road and Peak Road to Kaukapakapa. Continue to travel north for 1.6km to turn right into Kanohi Road. The refuel location is shown on the map below.

Refueling will take place on the left-hand side of the Rally Route only. Can service crews please follow the marshal's instructions by U-turning at Hellyer and Rix Road intersections to achieve the best use of the available space. Please also respect the local residents by keeping private driveways and the above intersections clear.
